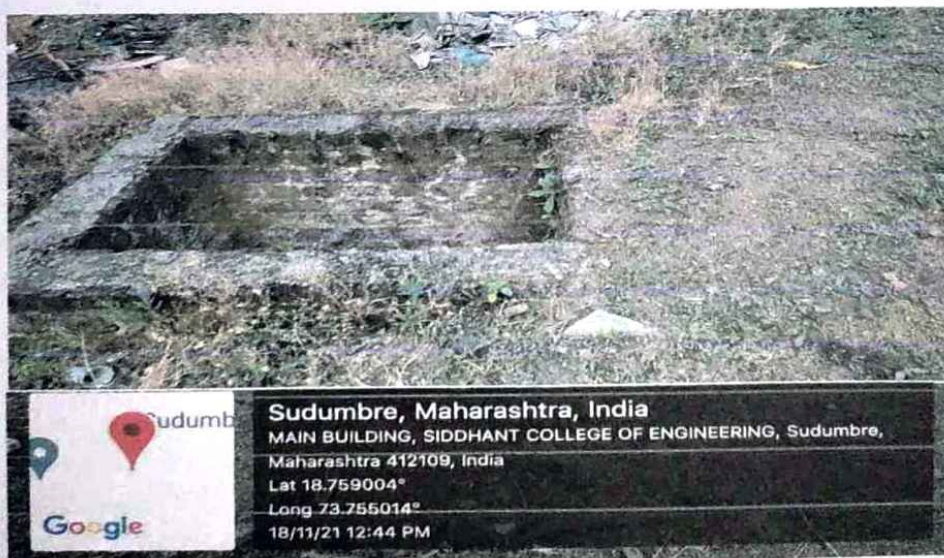
ZERO WASTE CAMPUS

There are 3 types of waste generated in the college as

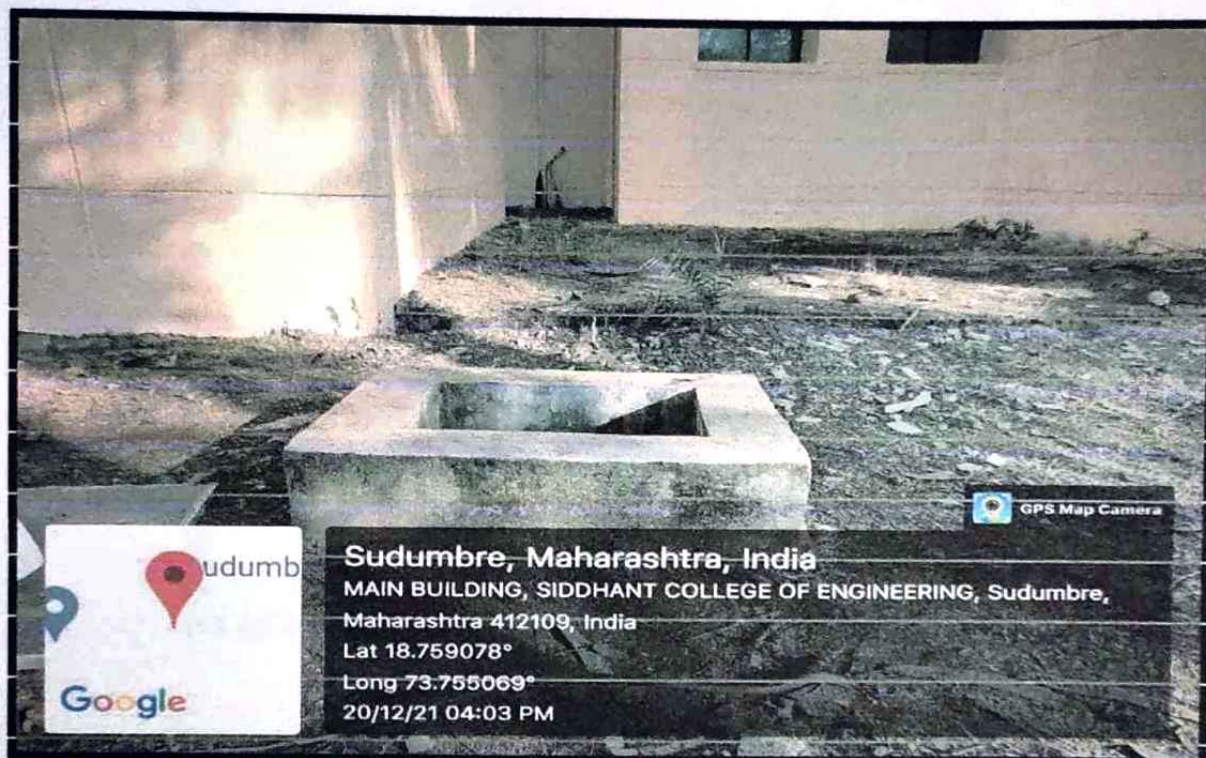
- 1.Solid waste Management

1. Solid waste Management – Solid waste like paper, rapper, shipment, food waste from canteen ,tree leaves, cut branches are managed to one corner of the campus and to make manure. 3.E Waste Management

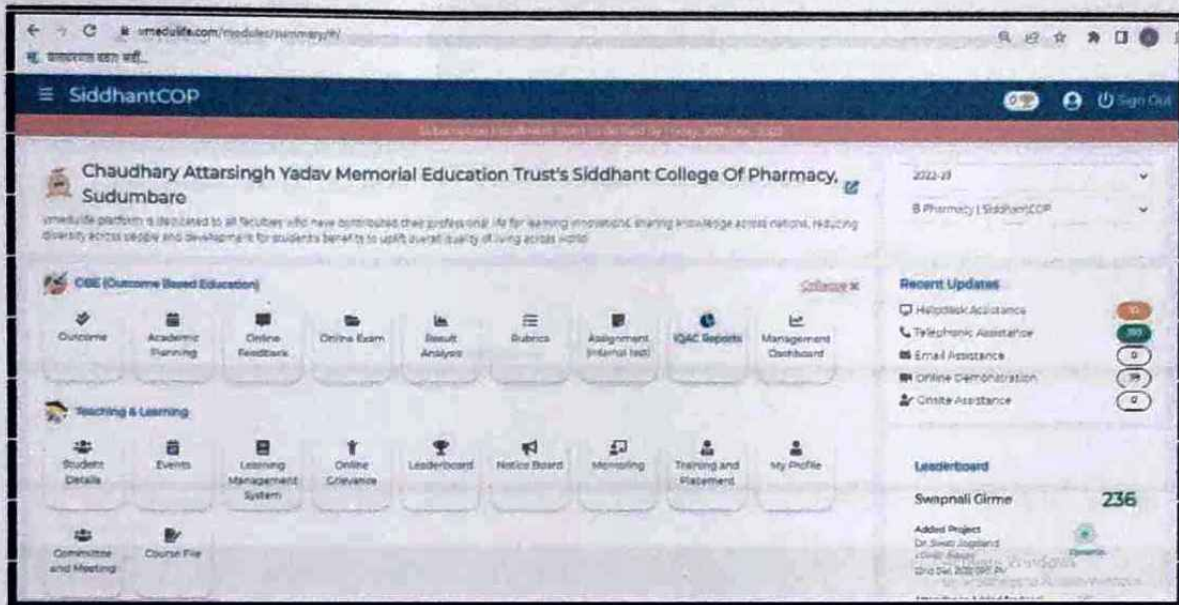

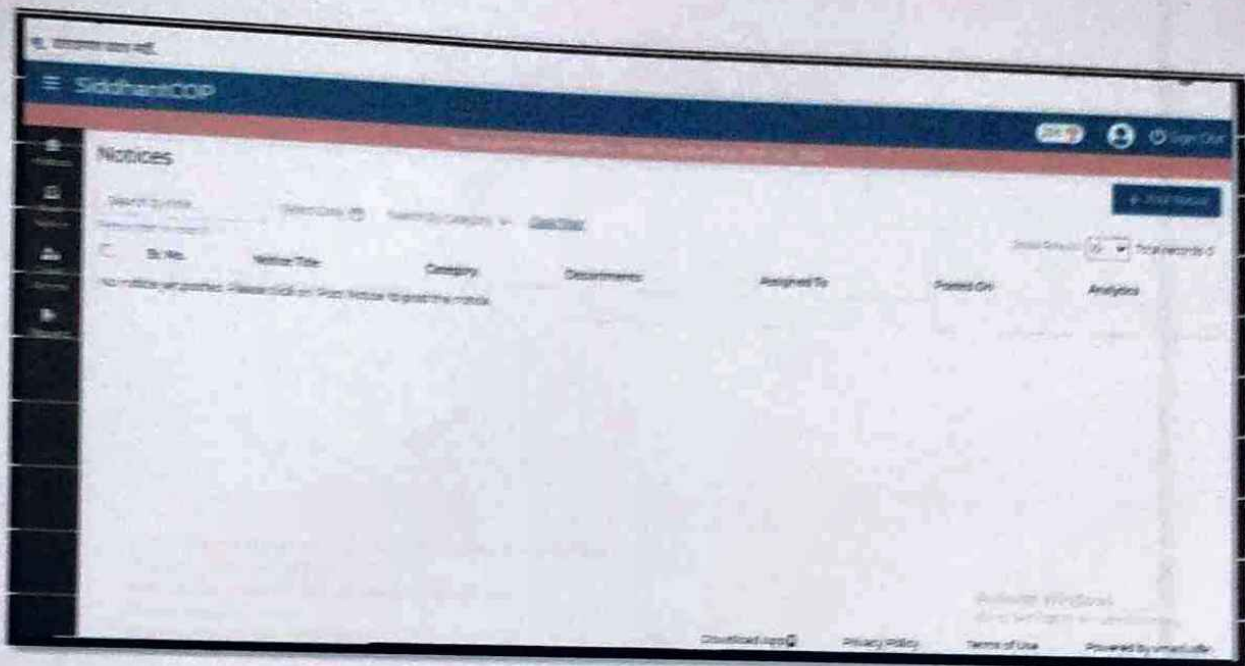

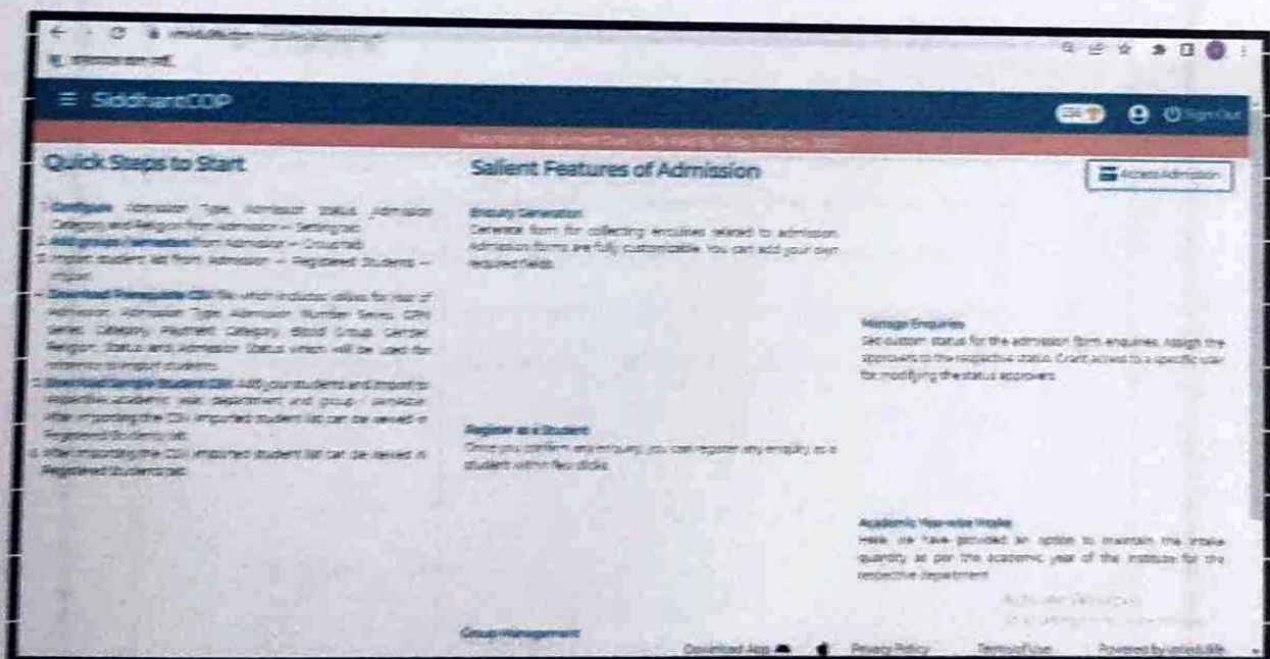
