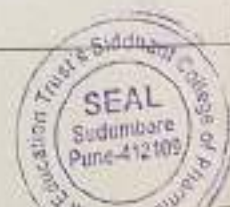

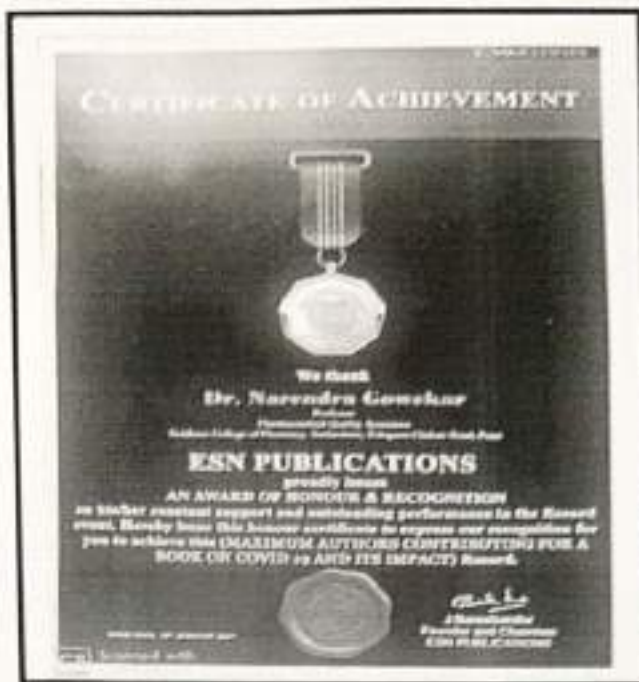


ACHIEVEMENTS BY STAFF AND STUDENTS
