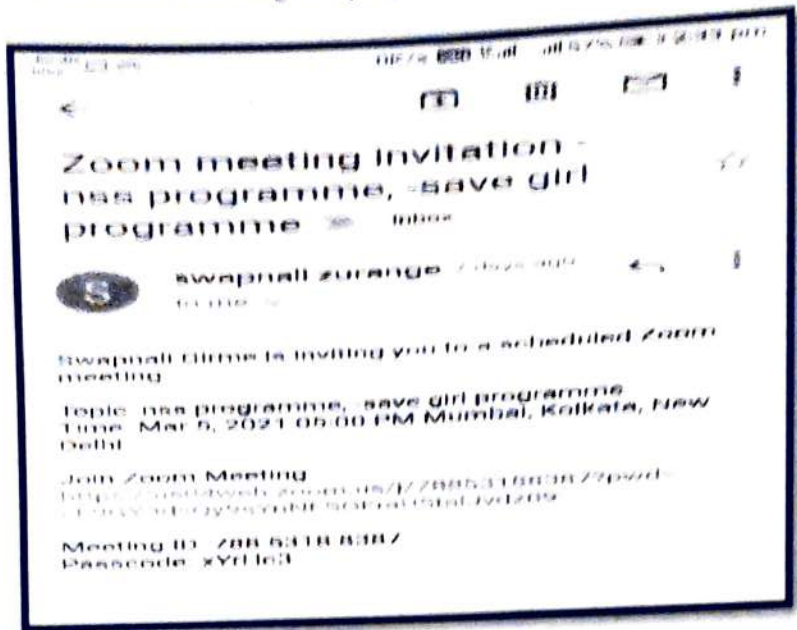

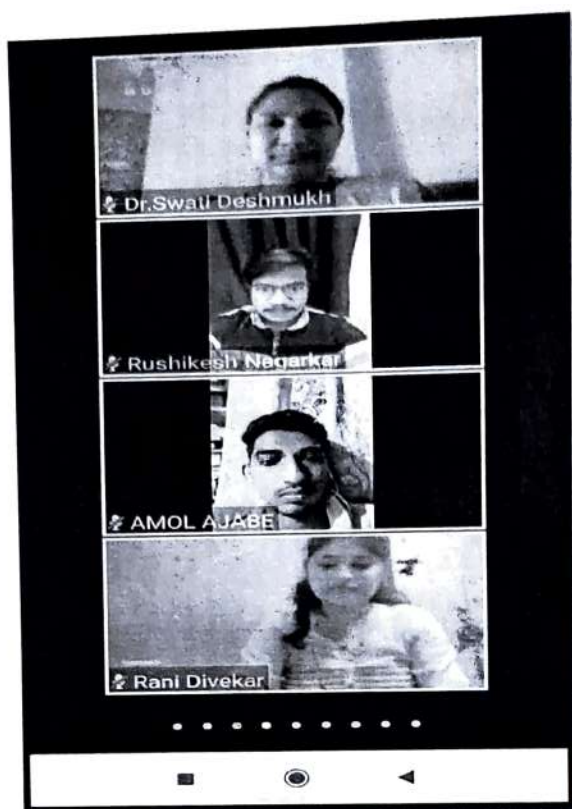

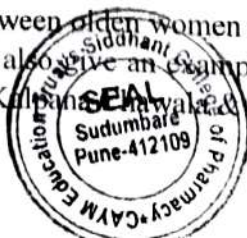
Summary:-

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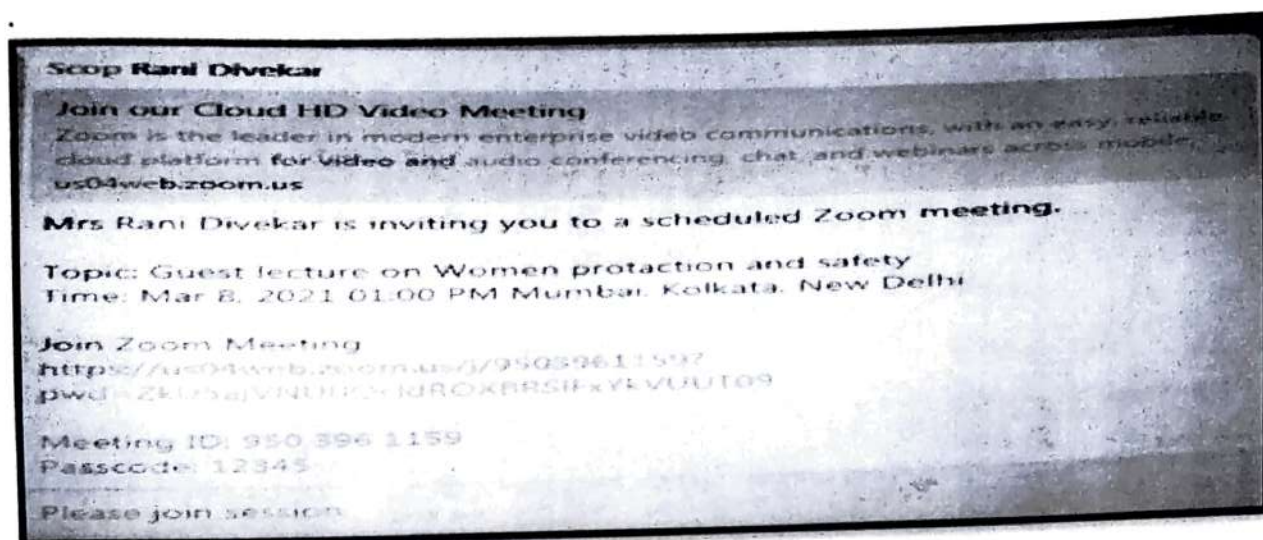


Photo 2: Mrs. Sarika Deore is speaker of our event "women protection and women safety delivered her thought on above topic

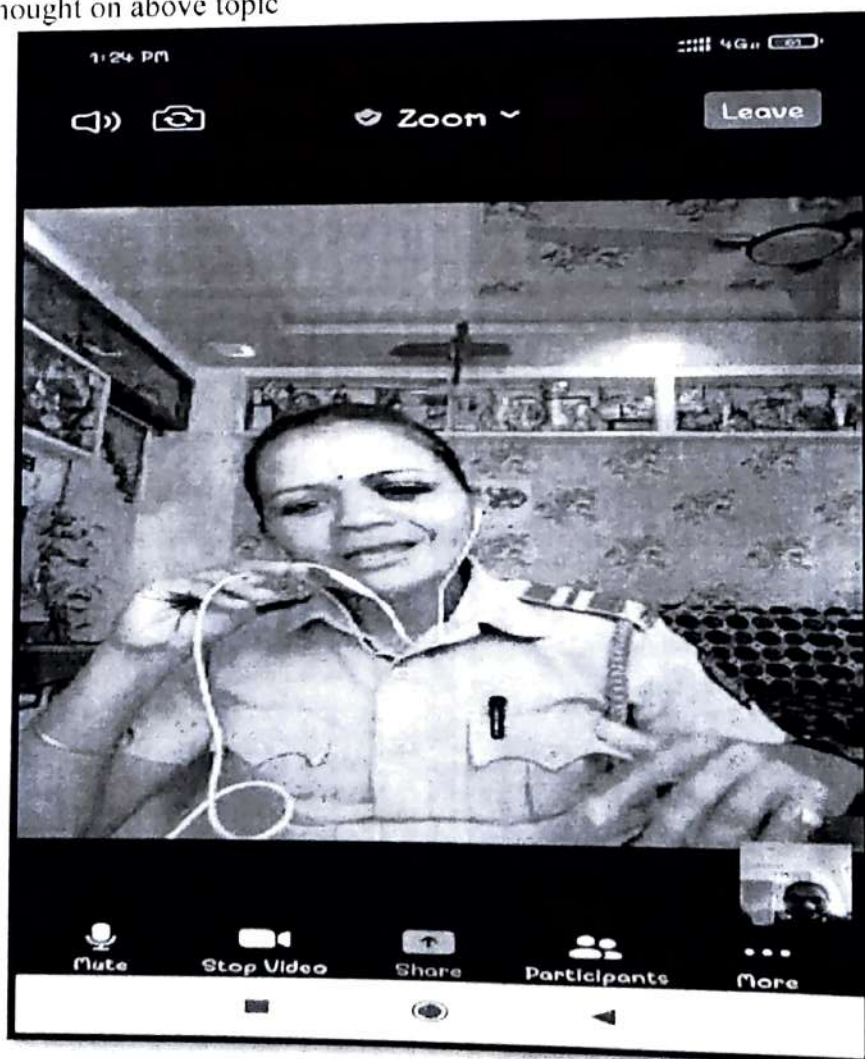


Photo 3: All teaching, Nonteaching and all student attend session

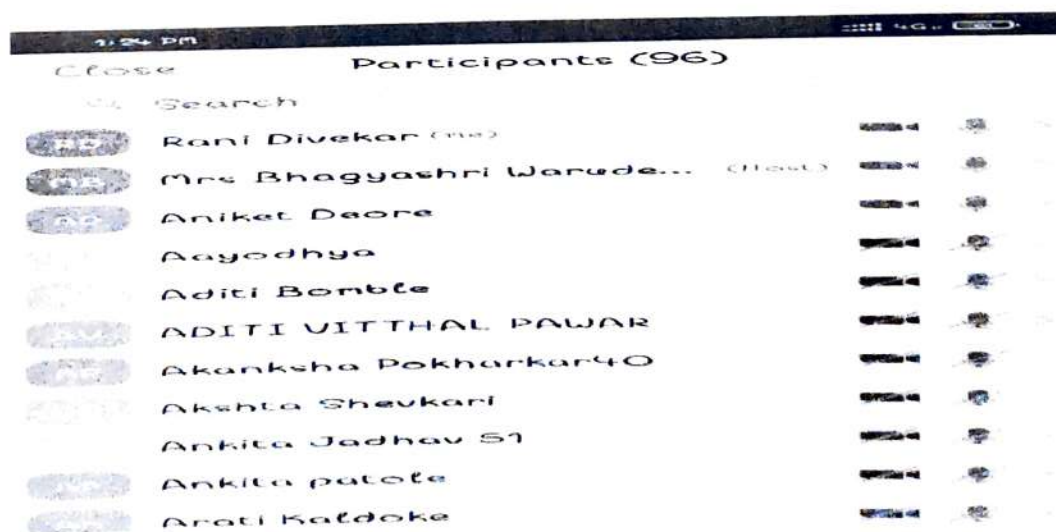
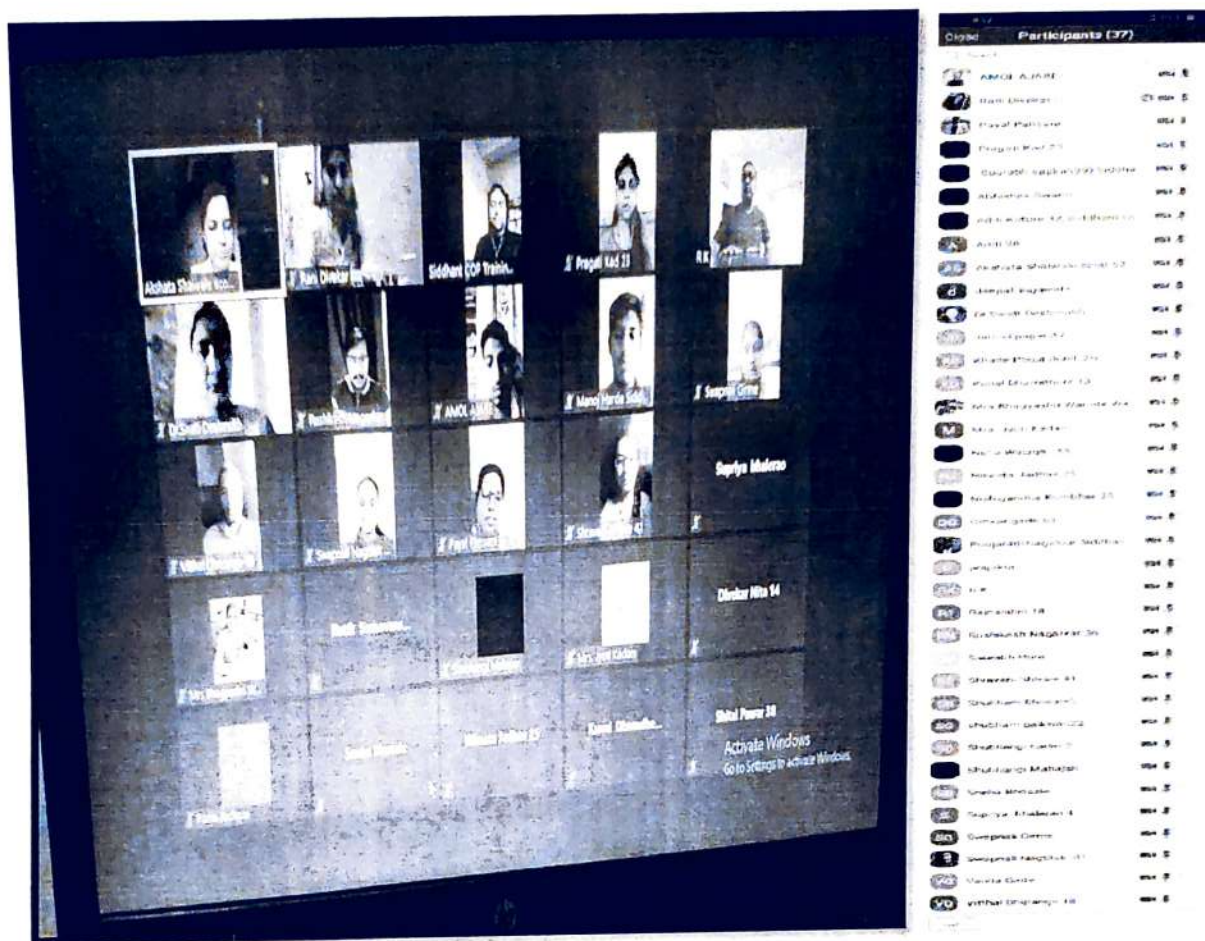
