2. THE COLLEGE Responsibilities:

- 2.1. Shall nominate one person with adequate accountability and responsibility to coordinate the Training Program. He / She would act as the single point of contact for the proposed Programme.
- 2.2. Shall make available the infrastructure (including IT infrastructure, applications and connectivity) required to conduct the Training Program.
- 2.3. Shall provide all the support services and facilities to **RUBICON** during the conduct of the said Training Program. Adequate power backup through UPS and DG supplies during the training sessions
- 2.4. Shall coordinate with RUBICON and facilitate conduct of all the assessments including the assessment to be conducted by the external agency (if any) identified by RUBICON, as per schedule communicated by RUBICON.
- 2.5. Provide lodging, wherever available, as per the standards of RUBICON for faculty conducting the Training Programme for the total duration of the Training Programme plus two days (one day prior and one day after closure). The lodging so planned to be provided should be with independent room (with attached toilet), regular water supply, clean, with access to boarding facilities, should have well lit approach and surroundings, have adequate safety & protection and peaceful environment.
- 2.6. Shall share the details of students in a prescribed format to ensure that there is no duplication of beneficiaries
- 2.7. This is a multi-year program to create social impact. The college shall share few details to assess the impact of the program. For e.g. Placement details of trained students will be required to assess the impact of the program from one year to another year.

3. Rubicon Responsibilities:

- 3.1. Will provide necessary training as per Training Programme requirements and curriculum for delivery as per Annexure I to this MOU
- 3.2. Will provide suitable faculties for the training exclusive for classroom training
- 3.3. Will conduct assessment of its own and also arrange external assessment as required.



4. Other Terms & Conditions:

The following are other terms and conditions of engagement:

- 4.1. Batch Size: The batch size would need to be a min/ max of 35-40.
- 4.2. Each student would be made available for the Training Program for specified number of hours per day for the duration of the Training Program
- 4.3. Pre-assessment & Selection: RUBICON may carry out pre-assessment of the students who have applied for the course and shortlist the select candidates to undergo the Training Program. The final decision on selection of candidates eligible to take the Training Program shall be with RUBICON.
- 4.4. Programme schedule:
 - 4.4.1. Training Program scheduled commencement date 5th March 2019
 - 4.4.2. Scheduled Completion Date: and will be completed by not later than : 7th March 2019
 - 4.5. Commercials
 - 4.5.1. Training Fees: The training Fees is as follows,

4.5.2. Payment Terms Not Applicable

4.6. Certification

Students who are successful in the assessment conducted by RUBICON shall be awarded a certificate post completion of the training program.

4.7. Term of engagement:

This MoU is valid from the date of sign off by both parties for a period of Two years, however both parties agree that based on mutual agreement, the terms may be extended. Both parties also agree that terms may be renegotiated.

4.8. Limitations and Warranties :

Both parties agree that it would be their endeavour to prevent any liability arising out of default or non-compliance of the MoU terms by the other party.

4.9. Termination

- 4.9.1. Both parties can terminate the MoU with a prior written thirty (30) day notice on default of terms of non-adherence to any condition or responsibilities by the other party as outlined in this MoU in case such default is not rectified within such 30 days.
- 4.9.2. Both parties also agree that it would be their professional endeavour that despite any termination of the MOU, progress would continue, without any prejudice to the ongoing Training Programmes, which would be without any hindrance and would be progressed for completion.

General Terms:

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- 5.1. Both the parties may receive information proprietary to other party (the Confidential Information) in the course of performance of their obligations under this MOU. Confidential Information is not meant to include any information which (a) is publicly available (b) is rightfully received by the parties from third parties without accompanying secrecy obligations; (c) is already in either party's possession and was lawfully received from sources other than the parties or (d) is independently developed by the parties. The two bodies understand and acknowledge that the Confidential Information is valuable and confidential and agrees that it will at all times be kept in trust to be disclosed only to such persons as have a "need to know" the same for the effective implementation of this MOU and that it will only be used by the parties for the benefit of others.
- 5.2. Both the parties understand and agree that all written or other tangible data and documentation developed or procured by the other party in performing its obligations under this MOU, whether in printed or electronic form, belongs to other party and that other party will have all rights, titles and interests therein.

- 5.3. Both parties shall not use the name and brand of other party in any advertisement or make any public announcement without the prior written approval of the other.
- 5.4. Each party shall be at liberty to terminate this MOU with a written notice period of three (3) month to the other party without any compensation and seeking legal redress.
- 6. Jurisdiction:

In the event of any litigation, the court of jurisdiction shall be Pune.

7. Indemnification

Both parties agree to indemnify each other and hold the other party harmless from and against any claim, loss, liability, or expense, including, but not limited to, damages, patent, and trademark infringement, costs and attorneys' fees, arising out of or in connection with any acts or omissions of their agents or employees, as related to the terms of this MoU.

Any claim, compensation, case initiated by any student against Aricent in relation to the Training Program due to any acts or omissions of COLLEGE and/or RUBICON shall be defended and contested by the COLLEGE and RUBICON at their sole expenses and cost keeping Aricent indemnified from the same.

8. Limitation of Liability:

Except for the indemnification obligations, both parties agree that the liability would be limited to the amount of actual transactions between the two parties


9 Notices:

11. Force Majeure:

- 11.1. Neither party to this MOU shall be liable for any failure or delay on its part in performing any of its obligations under this MOU, if such failure or delay shall be result of or arising out of Force Majeure conditions and, provided that the party claiming Force Majeure shall use its best efforts to avoid or remove such cause of non-performance and shall fulfil and continue performance hereunder with the utmost dispatch whenever and to the extent such cause or causes are removed.
- 11.2. Any extraordinary event, which cannot be controlled by the parties, shall for the purpose of this MOU be considered as a Force Majeure event. Such events include acts of God, acts or omissions of any Government or agency thereof, compliance with rules, regulations or order of any Government Authority. Provided however, if either party claims that existence of any of the aforesaid conditions is delaying or disabling the performance by said party of its obligations under this MOU, such party shall give immediate notice to the other party of the existence of such conditions whose existence are claimed to delay or disable the performance of obligations as aforesaid.



Tata Institute of Social Sciences (herein after referred to as "TISS"), a Deemed to be University under section 3 of the University Grants Commission Act (UGC) of India, 1956, is a premier institute in India in social sciences, human development and public policy, having its main campus at V.N. Purav Marg, Deonar, Mumbai-400088, herein referred to as 'First Party';

AND

Siddhant College of Pharmacy is situated at Sudumbre, Maharashtra 410501 affiliated to Savitribai Phule Pune University, hereinafter referred to as 'Second Party';

TISS and Siddhant College of Pharmacy shall herein after collectively be called "the parties" and individually as "the party".

1. STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

The employability of India's university graduates continues to remain weak even while there is an acute shortage of skilled manpower in an increasing number of high demand sectors. The youth are thus disillusioned about job opportunities post their studies. Though they have educational degrees, they lack the skills and the experience to get employed.

Skilling the youth to enhance their employability and enabling them to be effective contributors to the nation's growth and development assume paramount importance in the current context.

The Tata Institute of Social Sciences has been working to reach the youth through an innovative programme called 'National University Students' Skill Development (NUSSD)' for the same purpose. The aim is to enable the youth enrolled in the various degree programs in Colleges and Universities in India to acquire skills that would give them a Certificate/Diploma in a specific high demand domain area in addition to their degree. Students will be introduced to holistic education which encompasses components of employment-oriented training, exposure to community services, life skills training and civic education to fulfill the changing requirement of higher education

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and thereby bringing about vocationalisation of higher education. Eventually, this programme is poised to cover all the youth in the university system wanting to enhance their employment potential by gaining skills along with a graduate degree in their

2. PROGRAMME BACKGROUND

The National University Students' Skill Development (NUSSD) Programme is a unique initiative on skill development designed and delivered by the Tata Institute of Social Sciences (TISS). The programme was initiated in 2013 in collaboration with Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, Government of India (GoI) and National Skill Development Agency (NSDA), GoI to enable graduating youth acquire employable skills while pursuing their graduation or post-graduation so that they are job-ready as and when they pass out from the colleges. After completion of a successful pilot in 34 colleges of 11 Universities, spread across 9 States, the programme is being implemented across 200 colleges, including Engineering and Management colleges. The programme is currently in its second phase and covers a student population of more than 20000, spread across several states in the country. The United Nations (UN) Steering Committee on Children and Youth has recognized NUSSD programme among the best skill development practices in the country. NUSSD offers Certificate in Management and Soft Skills and skill-linked domain courses leading to a Diploma (e.g. Diploma in Entrepreneurship) to college going students. The

students enrolled in NUSSD Program are thus the NUSSD-TISS students. The classes are held in the participating College or University and the programme is designed on a schedule that minimizes disruption of regular studies and personal pursuits of 3. OBJECTIVES OF THE PROGRAMME

The MISSID program The NUSSD programme aims to increase employability of graduating youths by imparting knowledge, skills and competencies in relevant field. The programme also intends to develop the inner potential, critical thinking, and a sense of civic responsibility among students.



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Overall, the NUSSD programme aims at:

- 1. Enhancing employability skills of students to have a suitable career option after graduation.
- 2. Develop skills, competencies and knowledge to intervene in an equal and sustainable manner in the social and economic development of people.
- 3. Foster socially conscientious students grounded in respect for people and concerned about the welfare of others.

4. NUSSD COURSE STRUCTURE

NUSSD courses are developed by premier institutions/domain experts and subjected to scrutiny by accreditation bodies. Each course is reviewed by an expert committee on regular basis to incorporate and update the recent developments and changing requirements of the industry.

The NUSSD courses are built on the existing academic structure and add elements to enhance employability and build capacity to address key regional challenges and opportunities.

A number of other domain areas will be added as per the regional requirements and employment opportunities at different locations.

(v) Expert Teachers, Trainers, Internship and Field Work Facilitators

- From the catchment area of the College, a pool of experts from academia, industry, government, autonomous bodies and civil society are identified, assessed on competencies and enrolled to deliver course modules including lectures, tutorials and field work. Enrollment of teachers and trainers is done for each of the domain areas, and specific modules. The payment of teachers and trainers for each of the domain areas will be made on hourly basis after the successful delivery of particular course as per the NUSSD provisions.
 - From the pool of part-time teachers and trainers, key resource persons are being identified to teach and mentor students for each of the domain areas and specific skills.
 - Thus, a cohesive group of experts for each of the vocational education specialization is formed to deliver the course.

 NGOs and support agencies, industries and businesses are identified and enrolled to facilitate field work and internship. NGOs and support agencies may not be given financial compensation for the staff time provided.

5. <u>CERTIFICATION</u>

On successful completion of the programme, students will receive certification (Certificate and/or Diploma) from the National University Students' Skill Development Programme of TISS.

Certification (Certificate and/or Diploma) by the TISS-NUSSD may also carry the name of industry/academic partner to ensure that there is industry recognition to enhance employability of the graduates both locally and nationally.

6. OUTCOMES EXPECTED

It is expected that the successful implementation of NUSSD programme will enhance employability of the participants to a considerable level, enable them to gain certification which is recognized by Industry for skills and competencies, and also help in enhancing employability of the graduates both locally and nationally.

A good number of skilled graduates would emerge as transformation leaders after the successful completion of the course. Eventually, the availability of skilled human resources will be in several million college graduates.

7. COLLABORATION AGREEMENT

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Siddhant College of Pharmacy and TISS-NUSSD agree to explore and assist in developing mechanisms that will serve to encourage and enhance cooperative work between the institutions in areas of mutual interest, such as delivery of NUSSD courses through a dynamic partnership.

Siddhant College of Pharmacy shall provide all administrative and operational support to NUSSD programme by establishing an Office of NUSSD within the college campus. The roles and responsibilities of the parties are given below.

This MoU shall be valid for a period of nine months from the date of it being entered into and may be extended by the parties by mutual consent from time to time.

11.<u>CHANGES / AMMENDMENTS</u>

No change shall be made to this MoU without the written consent and signed approval of both the parties. Additions/deletions or alterations to this MoU may be effected with the prior written consent and approval concerning the particular change.
