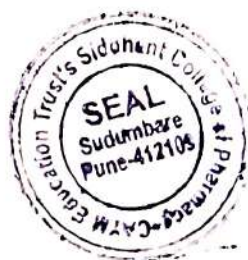



  
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### Felicitation of Winners students : Cultural Days and Sports

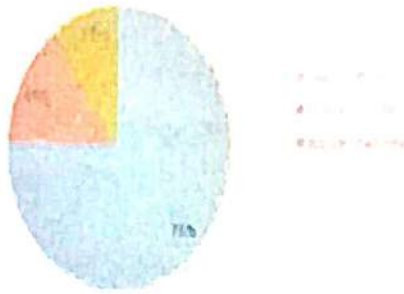

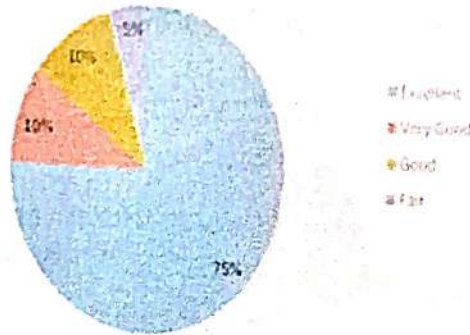

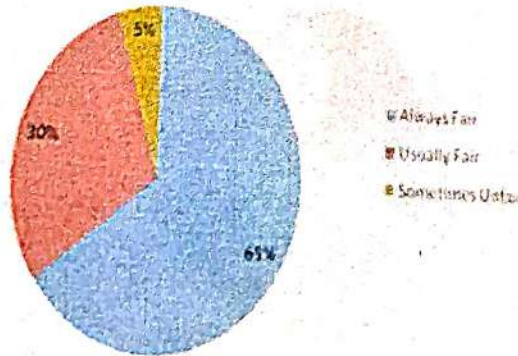

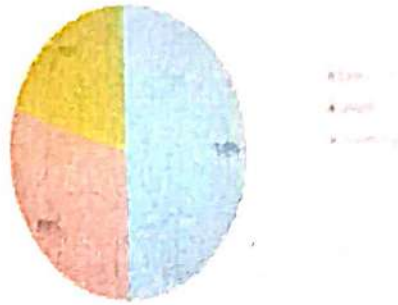

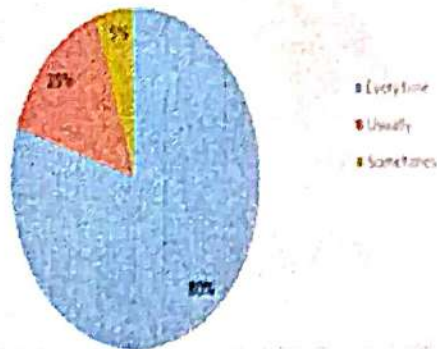

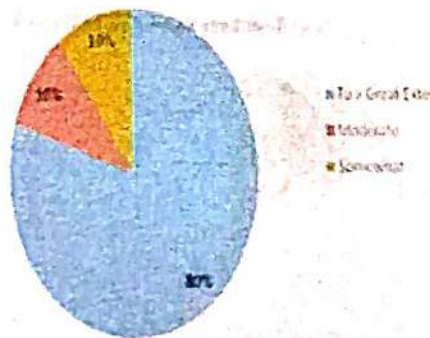

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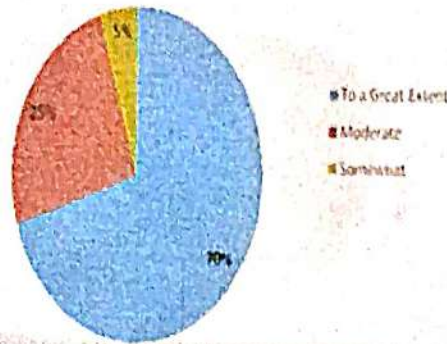

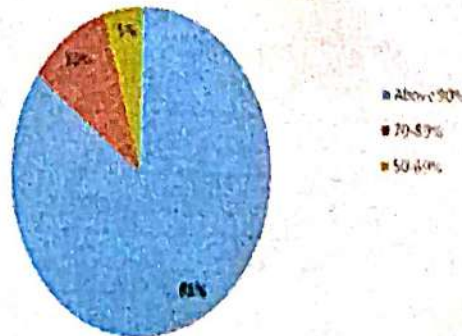

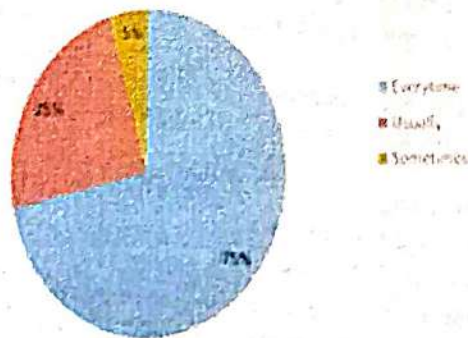
