
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



## 1. PURPOSE OF THE MOU:

#### BY AND BETWEEN

Tata Institute of Social Sciences (herein after referred to as "TISS"), a Deemed to be University under section 3 of the University Grants Commission Act (UGC) of India, 1956, is a premier institute in India in social sciences, human development and public policy, having its main campus at V.N. Purav Marg, Deonar, Mumbai-400088, herein referred to as 'First Party';

#### AND

Siddhant College of Pharmacy is situated at Sudumbre, Maharashtra 410501 affiliated to Savitribai Phule Pune University, hereinafter referred to as 'Second Party';

TISS and Siddhant College of Pharmacy shall herein after collectively be called "the parties" and individually as "the party".

#### 1. STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

The employability of India's university graduates continues to remain weak even while there is an acute shortage of skilled manpower in an increasing number of high demand sectors. The youth are thus disillusioned about job opportunities post their studies. Though they have educational degrees, they lack the skills and the experience to get employed.

Skilling the youth to enhance their employability and enabling them to be effective contributors to the nation's growth and development assume paramount importance in the current context.

The Tata Institute of Social Sciences has been working to reach the youth through an innovative programme called 'National University Students' Skill Development (NUSSD)' for the same purpose. The aim is to enable the youth enrolled in the various degree programs in Colleges and Universities in India to acquire skills that would give them a Certificate/Diploma in a specific high demand domain area in addition to their degree. Students will be introduced to holistic education which encompasses components of employment-oriented training, exposure to community services, life skills training and civic education to fulfill the changing requirement of higher education





and thereby bringing about vocationalisation of higher education. Eventually, this programme is poised to cover all the youth in the university system wanting to enhance their employment potential by gaining skills along with a graduate degree in their chosen discipline

#### 2. PROGRAMME BACKGROUND

The National University Students' Skill Development (NUSSD) Programme is a unique initiative on skill development designed and delivered by the Tata Institute of Social Sciences (TISS). The programme was initiated in 2013 in collaboration with Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, Government of India (GoI) and National Skill Development Agency (NSDA), GoI to enable graduating youth acquire employable skills while pursuing their graduation or post-graduation so that they are job-ready as and when they pass out from the colleges. After completion of a successful pilot in 34 colleges of 11 Universities, spread across 9 States, the programme is being implemented across 200 colleges, including Engineering and Management colleges. The programme is currently in its second phase and covers a student population of more than 20000, spread across several states in the country.

The United Nations (UN) Steering Committee on Children and Youth has recognized NUSSD programme among the best skill development practices in the country.

NUSSD offers Certificate in Management and Soft Skills and skill-linked domain courses leading to a Diploma (e.g. Diploma in Entrepreneurship) to college going students. The students enrolled in NUSSD Program are thus the NUSSD-TISS students. The classes are held in the participating College or University and the programme is designed on a schedule that minimizes disruption of regular studies and personal pursuits of participating students.

## 3. OBJECTIVES OF THE PROGRAMME

The NUSSD programme aims to increase employability of graduating youths by imparting knowledge, skills and competencies in relevant field. The programme also intends to develop the inner potential, critical thinking, and a sense of civic responsibility among students.



Overall, the NUSSD programme aims at:

- Enhancing employability skills of students to have a suitable career option after graduation.
- Develop skills, competencies and knowledge to intervene in an equal and sustainable manner in the social and economic development of people.
- Foster socially conscientious students grounded in respect for people and concerned about the welfare of others.

#### 4. NUSSD COURSE STRUCTURE

NUSSD courses are developed by premier institutions/domain experts and subjected to scrutiny by accreditation bodies. Each course is reviewed by an expert committee on regular basis to incorporate and update the recent developments and changing requirements of the industry.

The NUSSD courses are built on the existing academic structure and add elements to enhance employability and build capacity to address key regional challenges and opportunities.

#### (i) Course Curriculum Details

#### · Credits earned

- ✓ Certificate Course (Foundation course/ 20 credits\*)
- ✓ Domain Diploma (Domain Certificate course + 20 credits\*)

{1 Credit\* = 15 Hours of Classroom Training OR 30 Hours of Internship}

#### · Curriculum Development, Expert Group and Accreditation

- Group of Skill Area Specialization Experts drawn from academia, government and industry in each of skill areas as well as competencies, develop curriculum in specific specializations.
- The expert group evolves criteria for course delivery, assessment and accreditation.
- ✓ The Course is accredited by the Academic Council of the Tata Institute of Social Sciences (TISS).

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### (ii) Course Design

- NUSSD Courses are designed in a modular, interlinked and interactive manner; cumulatively building knowledge, skills, and competencies administered through classes and field work.
- The course credits are spread over the years (Second and Third) of graduation and the students are taught courses (lectures and tutorials) followed by Field work / Internship in appropriate work location.
- Field work / internship in urban / rural contexts in community and industrial set up are organized during holiday /vacation to gain hands-on practical experience.
- During the training, students will be introduced to the purpose of NUSSD programme and need for skill development through a series of interactive sessions at the university and its affiliated colleges.

# (iii) Foundation skills for professional competencies

Students enrolled for NUSSD's Certificate in Management and Soft Skills course will gain competency in following areas - (Foundation Courses for professional competencies):

## Certificate in Management and Soft Skills

- 1. English Communication
- Youth Leadership & People Skills
- 3. Legal Literacy
- 4. Financial Literacy
- Digital Literacy
- Working with Communities (leading to a field practicum)

Competency in digital application would be integral part of gaining competency in other modules; and subsequent skill development process.

(iv) Domain Specific Training

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## Domain Courses (Phase 2)- Diploma in Specific Domain

Student can choose any one inter-related skill areas in their third year of graduation.

- Diploma in Banking and Financial Services
- 2. Diploma in Hospital Services Management
- 3. Diploma in Digital Marketing
- 4. Diploma in Business, Accounts and Taxation
- 5. Diploma in Export and Import Management
- Diploma in Logistics and Supply Chain Management
- 7. Diploma in Physician Assistant
- 8. Diploma in Sustainable Agriculture
- 9. Diploma in Sales and Marketing
- 10. Diploma in Fashion Designing
- 11. Diploma in Retail Management
- 12. Diploma in Entrepreneurship

A number of other domain areas will be added as per the regional requirements and employment opportunities at different locations.

## (v) Expert Teachers, Trainers, Internship and Field Work Facilitators

- From the catchment area of the College, a pool of experts from academia, industry, government, autonomous bodies and civil society are identified, assessed on competencies and enrolled to deliver course modules including lectures, tutorials and field work. Enrollment of teachers and trainers is done for each of the domain areas, and specific modules. The payment of teachers and trainers for each of the domain areas will be made on hourly basis after the successful delivery of particular course as per the NUSSD provisions.
- From the pool of part-time teachers and trainers, key resource persons are being identified to teach and mentor students for each of the domain areas and specific skills.
- Thus, a cohesive group of experts for each of the vocational education specialization is formed to deliver the course.

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 NGOs and support agencies, industries and businesses are identified and enrolled to facilitate field work and internship. NGOs and support agencies may not be given financial compensation for the staff time provided.

#### 5. CERTIFICATION

On successful completion of the programme, students will receive certification (Certificate and/or Diploma) from the National University Students' Skill Development Programme of TISS.

Certification (Certificate and/or Diploma) by the TISS-NUSSD may also carry the name of industry/academic partner to ensure that there is industry recognition to enhance employability of the graduates both locally and nationally.

#### 6. OUTCOMES EXPECTED

It is expected that the successful implementation of NUSSD programme will enhance employability of the participants to a considerable level, enable them to gain certification which is recognized by Industry for skills and competencies, and also help in enhancing employability of the graduates both locally and nationally.

A good number of skilled graduates would emerge as transformation leaders after the successful completion of the course. Eventually, the availability of skilled human resources will be in several million college graduates.

## 7. COLLABORATION AGREEMENT

Siddhant College of Pharmacy and TISS-NUSSD agree to explore and assist in developing mechanisms that will serve to encourage and enhance cooperative work between the institutions in areas of mutual interest, such as delivery of NUSSD courses through a dynamic partnership.

Siddhant College of Pharmacy shall provide all administrative and operational support to NUSSD programme by establishing an Office of NUSSD within the college campus. The roles and responsibilities of the parties are given below.

## 9. FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

NUSSD-TISS will charge a nominal course registration fee of Rs. 500/ - (Five Hundred Only) to its students to make them accountable and to ensure their commitment to complete the course and also to sustain the programme.

## 10.DURATION / TERM OF THE MOU

This MoU shall be valid for a period of nine months from the date of it being entered into and may be extended by the parties by mutual consent from time to time.

## 11.CHANGES / AMMENDMENTS

No change shall be made to this MoU without the written consent and signed approval of both the parties. Additions/deletions or alterations to this MoU may be effected with the prior written consent and approval concerning the particular change. Documents containing such additions, deletions and/or alterations should be signed by both the Parties and shall form a part of this MoU, and be deemed to be part of this MoU from the date of such amendment.

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#### 12.TERMINATION

This MoU can be recommended for termination by the parties after serving 3 (three) months' notice in writing. However, if there is failure or breach of understanding or default by either party other than on force majeure grounds it shall be terminated with one month's notice. However, based on unsatisfactory performance and or other reasons TISS-NUSSD may terminate or amend any of the understanding as stated above.

This MOU shall be effective upon the signature of Parties through their authorized officials.

The Institute is a linguistic minority institute, approved by All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) and the Pharmacy Council of India. The Institute is affiliated to Savitribai Phule Pune University and recognized by the Government of

The Institute offers the Diploma of Pharmacy(D. Pharm), Bachelor of Pharmacy (B. Pharm) and Master of Pharmacy (M. Pharm) courses on its campus with admission to the course being done on merit evaluated on the basis of the marks scored in the entrance examination. The Institute's faculty is also highly qualified and are alumni of various reputed universities.

The party of the second part, the Hospital is a charitable trust hospital engaged in providing medical services and has agreed to allow the Institute's students (the "Apprentices")undertake apprenticeship training in the Hospitalas per the Apprenticeship Act, 1961 and amendments thereof, to increase their employability and social standing.

- 1. The Parties agree that the apprenticeship training will involve the following learning outcomes:
  - 1.1 identifying the drugs and managingthe pharmacy processes;
  - 1.2 learning about inpatient & outpatient departments' medication procedures;
  - getting working knowledge of keeping records required by various Acts 1.3 concerning the profession of Pharmacist;
  - reading, translation and copying of prescriptions including checking of 1.4 doses;
  - dispensing of prescription illustrating the common methods of 1.5 administering medicaments; and
  - the storage of drugs and medical preparations.
- The Hospital will conduct the campus interviews every year in the month of June for shortlisting of final year D.Pharm and B. Pharm students for apprenticeship training as per the schedule communicated by the Institute to the Hospital. The apprenticeship training will commence once the required documentation is successfully uploaded on the National Apprenticeship Training Scheme (NATS)Portal.
- The Parties agree to the following terms and conditions to be fulfilled by each 3. other in relation to the apprenticeship training:
  - 3.1 The practical training during the apprenticeship training program shall be for a period of one (1) year.



- 3.2 All students undertaking the apprenticeship training should have cleared their D.Pharm or B. Pharm final year exams and should provide the original marksheet and diploma / degree certificate.
- 3.3 Students who have graduated in the last two years are also eligible for apprenticeship training provided they do not have any prior work experience.
- 3.4 The apprentice shall not undertake any other full-time or part-time course during the entire period of his / her apprenticeship training.
- 3.5 The work timings for apprenticeship training will be from 09:00 AM to 05:00 PM with a fixed weekly off.
- 3.6 The apprenticeship training shall not be less than eight hours a day and six days a week.
- 3.7 The apprentice will not be permitted to work anywhere else, either full-time or part-time while he / she is undertaking the apprenticeship training.
- 3.8 The apprentice will not be allowed any leaveduring their apprenticeship training except the National Holidays which are provided as per statutory norms.
- 3.9 A monthly stipend will be paid to the apprentice based on the category under which they are selected for the apprenticeship training (₹10,000/-for D.Pharm and ₹12,000/- for B.Pharm per month respectively), until any
- 3.10 The apprentice will not be eligible for any other benefits or privileges which are given to the regular employees of the Hospital.
- 3.11 The apprentice will be required to perform all such duties across all pharmacy stores within the Hospitalpremises as per the training imparted to them during their apprenticeship period.
- 3.12 The apprentice shall abide by the rules and regulations of the Hospital which are in existence and may be amended from time to time or which may be brought into force later, including but not limited to all Hospital policies.
- 3.13 The Hospital Management reserves the right to terminate the apprenticeship contract with the Apprentice if there is any unauthorized absenteeism or if he / she has been convicted by any court of law for offences involving moral turpitude before or during the period of apprenticeship training.
- 3.14 The apprenticeship contract with the apprentices can be terminated by either Party any time during the apprenticeship period by giving a twenty-four (24) hours' notice.



- 3.15 The Hospital will not provide an Apprenticeship Training Completion Certificate to any of the apprentices if the apprenticeship contract is terminated within the stipulated period of one year from the date of commencement of the apprenticeship programme.
- 3.16 The Apprentice shall not disclose or divulge or make public, except on legal obligations, any information regarding hospital matters and administration or research carried out, whether the same be confined to you or become known to you in the course of your apprenticeship training or otherwise. The Apprentice shall observe strict secrecy regarding the hospital business and shall not divulge directly or indirectly or disclose to any person any affairs or any information regarding the hospital. The Apprentice shall not publish any article or statement, broadcast or make any communication to the media (whether print or electronic) relating to the Hospital's business and affairs.
- 3.17 The Apprentices shall be responsible for safe keeping and returning in good condition and order the properties of the Hospital which may be in their custody / care or charge.
- 3.18 The Hospitalshall guide and train the Apprentices during their apprenticeship training.
- The Institute shall notify the Hospital in advance and in writing in case of any changes in the academic schedule that may affect the apprenticeship timing.
- The Hospital shall not be responsible for paying any allowance, conveyance, or any other cost incurred by the students or the Institute for the apprenticeship training other than the apprenticeship stipend.
- The Instituteshall be solely liable in case of any complications, damage and legal
  proceedings'raised by any patient against any Apprentices posted for apprenticeship
  training and shall bear the expenses of all legal procedures including counsel fees,
  legal documentation and costs arising out of it.
- The Institute shall provide an identity card and uniform to the Apprentice undertaking the apprenticeship training and the Apprentices may be asked to show their identity cards at any time during their apprenticeship training by the Hospital authorities.
- The Hospitalshall have the sole discretion to limitthe apprenticeship training, including the termination of the apprenticeship training, if any Apprentice is found to have violated the rules and regulations of the Hospital, breached the confidentiality policy, or displayed behavior unacceptable to the Hospital.
- The Parties hereto shall be true and faithful to each other and shall not do or cause to be done anything which may be detrimental to the interest of either party.



- 10. The Hospitalmay seek the assistance of any legal or law enforcement authorities in case of any major incident like theft, cybercrime, physical or mental harassment of any member of the Hospital or patient and relative and the like reported against any Apprentice and take suitable actions as may deem fit.
- The Institute shall give the opportunity and priority to the Hospitalshould the Hospital be interested in interviewing and hiring any Apprenticeon the successful completion of his-her apprenticeship training.
- The Hospitalmay consider interviewing any Apprentice on the successful completion of his/her apprenticeship training to recruit them to the Hospital if any vacancy exists.
- 13. TERM:

This MoU is effective from Friday.01<sup>st</sup> July 2022 and shall be valid for a period of three years up to Monday, 30<sup>th</sup> June 2025.

14. VARIATION:

No variation or modification of this MoU shall be of any force or effect unless the same shall be confirmed in writing and signed by both parties.

15. TERMINATION:

The MoU can be terminated by either Party at any time by giving six months' advance written notice and before the commencement of the next academic year.

16. GOVERNING LAW AND JURISDICTION:

This MoU shall be governed by and construed and enforced in accordance with Indian law. The courts in Pune alone shall have the jurisdiction to entertain, try and decide all disputes, differences, and claims arising under this MoU.







- 4-9-2 Both parties also agree that it would be their professional endeavour that despite any termination of the MOU, progress would continue, without any prejudice to the ongoing Training Programmes, which would be without any hindrance and would be progressed for completion.

### General Terms:

- Both the parties may receive information proprietary to other party (the Confidential Information) in the course of performance of their obligations under this MOU. Confidential Information is not meant to include any information which (a) is publicly available (b) is rightfully received by the parties from third parties without accompanying secrecy obligations; (c) is already meither party's possession and was lawfully received from sources other than the parties or (d) is independently developed by the parties. The two bodies understand and acknowledge that the Confidential Information is valuable and confidential and agrees that it will at all times be kept in trust to be disclosed only to such persons as have a "need to know" the same for the effective implementation of this MOU and that it will only be used by the parties for the benefit of others.
- 5.2 Both the parties understand and agree that all written or other tangible data and documentation developed or procured by the other party in performing its obligations under this MOU, whether in printed or electronic form, belongs to other party and that other party will have all rights, titles and interests therein.

- Both parties shall not use the name and brand of other party in any advertisement or make any public announcement without the prior written approval of the other
- 5.4 Each part, shall be at liberty to terminate this MOU with a written notice period of three (3) month to the other party without any compensation and seeking legal redress.

#### 6 Jurisdiction:

in the event of any hitigation, the court of jurisdiction shall be Pune.

### Indemnification

Both parties agree to indemnify each other and hold the other party harmless from and against any claim, loss, liability, or expense, including, but not limited to, damages, patent, and trademark infringement, costs and attorneys' fees, arising out of or in connection with any acts or omissions of their agents or employees, as related to the terms of this MoU.

Any claim, compensation, case initiated by any student against Aricent in relation to the Training Program due to any acts or omissions of COLLEGE and/or RUBICON shall be defended and contested by the COLLEGE and RUBICON at their sole expenses and cost keeping Aricent indemnified from the same.

#### 8. Limitation of Liability:

Except for the indemnification obligations, both parties agree that the liability would be limited to the amount of actual transactions between the two parties

### 9. Notices:

Any notices under this MOU will be sent by certified or registered mail, return receipt requested, to the respective address of Parties as contained in this MOU. Such notice will be effective upon its mailing as specified.

- Property Rights or its unlawful use, under prevalent laws of India. Further, each of the party herein, agrees to co-operate with the other to the extent possible in the process of investigating such cases of any violation of intellectual Property Rights or its unlawful use and taking legal action against the said infringement.

Provided however, if either party claims that existence of any of the aforesaid conditions is delaying or disabling the performance by said party of its obligations under this MOU, such party shall give immediate notice to the other party of the existence of such conditions whose existence are claimed to delay or disable the performance of obligations as aforesaid.
